Hodges Family Reunion 2015 - August 7th through 9th Hotel Information

We have a block of rooms (register under CODE **HFR** -Hodges Family Reunion) at the **Homewood Suites in Forsyth**, at **333 West Marion Ave., Forsyth, IL 62535. Phone 217-877-0887.**

The rooms are \$129.71 (all tax and fees included) per night. The rooms are all large king bed rooms with a pull out sofa. The price of the room also includes a very nice breakfast buffet in the hotel. To get the group rate you will need to make your reservation- under code **HFR - Hodges Family Reunion -BEFORE July 7, 2015**. Since this is the Celebration weekend, hotel rooms in town may be hard to come by.
